WEB PAGE POLICY Shenandoah Public Library

The Board of Trustees of the Shenandoah Public Library recognizes that access to the wealth of information and ideas on the Internet is essential to patrons and that making services known to the patrons through electronics, as well as through other sources, increases patrons' abilities to maximize the value of their investment in library services.

The sources listed or linked from the library web page have been chosen in keeping with the Library's Selection and Collection Development Policy and deemed generally reliable and useful. Patrons should be advised however that the Internet contains information which may be inaccurate, outdated, or personally offensive. Web pages are added, discontinued, or changed dramatically and frequently.

As with all library materials, patrons must evaluate the quality of the information accessed. Assistance in learning how to judge web page content is available through the librarians at the Shenandoah Public Library. Patrons remain personally responsible for any actions taken by them due to information found on or through the library web page. Parents are advised to monitor their own children's Internet use.

Patrons who feel the information obtained through the Internet is inaccurate or offensive should contact the original producer or distributor of that information.

Patrons are welcome to notify the Library if a web page link is no longer operational.

The availability of the access does not constitute endorsement of the content by Shenandoah Public Library.

No paid advertising is accepted for the library web page.
